DELTA SKATING CLUB - Junior Development Program

An introductory figure skating program for young skaters, age 6 – 10 years old who have completed the first three CanSkate Stages 1 – 3 and who demonstrate potential beyond the recreational level. **Junior Development** is the next stage for skaters to bridge the gap between CanSkate group lessons and StarSkate Programs when skaters begin private lessons in preparation for competitions and Skate Canada Tests. The program introduces skaters to freeskate, skating skills & dances through **TWO ON ICE & TWO OFF ICE Classes per week.** The class is divided into groups based on age and ability with a max. of 10 skaters in each group with one Skate Canada coach per group.

Skaters are encouraged to supplement this program with either a Private lesson or a Group Enrichment class. An optional Ballet class is also available.

Proper skating attire is required for the Junior Development program and will be discussed the first day of class and more information can be found on the website.
